- The temple, built against the cliffs, celebrates the legacy of one of Egypt's few female rulers.
- The journey ends with a transfer to Luxor Airport for departure, concluding a memorable exploration of Egypt's ancient past.

EGYPT - VISA REQUIREMENTS :

Note: Indian, Pakistani are eligible for Visa on arrival to Egypt with Passport and UAE residence visa of minimum 6 months with visa of USD 25.

Other nationalities please check with us for arrival eligibility.

In case required E-visa to avoid queue at the airport or for residents & non-uae residents we can apply E-visa for certain Nationalities only.

Following documents are required for Egypt Tourist eVisa:

1. Passport with Validity of 6 months from date of travel.
2. Guarantee/Invitation Letter (from Egypt)

Visa charges: AED 150 per person (Single Entry)

Processing Time: 4-5 working days.
