NEPAL - VISA REQUIREMENTS:

The documents you must have with you when you apply for a Nepal Visa On Arrival are:

- 1. Your original passport, which is valid for at least another six months and has at least two blank visa pages
- 2. Photocopies of the personal information page of your passport
- 3. At least one recent passport-size picture of yourself (1.5inch x 1.5inch with a white background). However, you should take more than one because you will need it if you want to extend the visa, when paying the fee, or other purposes that may arise.
- 4. The completed and signed Nepal Visa Application Form (completed online and printed)
- 5. Proof of accommodation in Nepal (such as a hotel reservation or an address)
- 6. Valid return flight or travel ticket
- 7. Proof of sufficient financial means, such as bank statements from the last three months
- 8. Proof of having paid the Nepal visa fee

NOTE:

Every foreign national who wants to enter Nepal needs a visa, except nationals of India. Additionally, nationals of the following countries need to get a visa before they travel to Nepal, while everyone else can obtain a Nepal visa on arrival:

Afghanistan, Cameroon, Eswatini, Ethiopia, Ghana, Iraq, Liberia, Nigeria, Palestine, Somalia, Syria, Zimbabwe

Cancellation Policy:
