

- Boudhanath: (UNESCO World Heritage Site) is the centre of Tibetan culture in Nepal. The 36-meter-high Stupa of Boudhanath is one of the largest Stupas in South Asia.
- Later, check-in to your hotel and relax.
- Overnight stay at your hotel in Kathmandu.

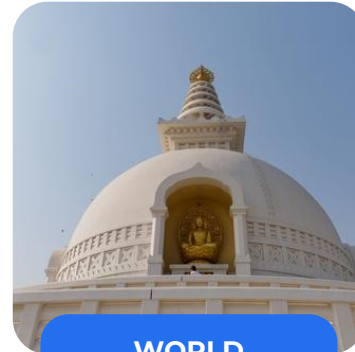

## Nepal Visa requirements

The documents you must have with you when you apply for a Nepal Visa On Arrival are:

1. Your original passport, which is valid for at least another six months and has at least two blank visa pages
2. Photocopies of the personal information page of your passport
3. At least one recent passport-size picture of yourself (1.5inch x 1.5inch with a white background). However, you should take more than one because you will need it if you want to extend the visa, when paying the fee, or other purposes that may arise.
4. The completed and signed Nepal Visa Application Form (completed online and printed)
5. Proof of accommodation in Nepal (such as a hotel reservation or an address)
6. Valid return flight or travel ticket
7. Proof of sufficient financial means, such as bank statements from the last three months
8. Proof of having paid the Nepal visa fee

### **NOTE:**

All passengers will require to complete the on-arrival visa application form no before than 15 days prior to their arrival.
